Registration – will be held at City Hall 3650 N.E. 12 Avenue, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. beginning June 21 to August 13 for Oakland Park residents and from June 28 to August 13 for non-residents. The fee is \$50 for residents and \$90 for non-residents. Proof of residency is required for the resident fee. Players must be between the ages of 6 and 16 by August 13, 2010. Proof of age is required. Space is limited.

You can now register Online! This is a service that the City of Oakland Park has initiated to make it more convenient for our residents and participants to sign up for a variety of Parks & Leisure Services programs and pay by credit card. Participants will initially have to verify Oakland Park residency with proper documentation, in person, at City Hall. Football Evaluation – Player evaluation will be held at Wimberly Athletic Complex, 4000 N.E. 3 Avenue. Players will be divided into 3 leagues, depending upon the age spread at the close of registration and are subject to change. Participants may be assigned within their divisions by gender, depending on enrollment. In order to evenly balance the teams, the staff has the option of moving players from team to team and league to league before the season begins.
