

STOCK LIST, RECORDS, INVENTORY, AND ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS

Sec. 7-44. Stock list to be available; books and records to be kept.

(a) A duplicate original of the application and stock list pursuant to which a permit was issued under this article shall at all times be available, at the place of sale, to the license inspector, who may examine all merchandise in the premises or in the warehouses for comparison with such stock list.

(b) Suitable books and records, as prescribed by the license inspector, shall be kept by the person conducting a sale under this article and shall, during business hours, be available to the license inspector. At the close of business each day, the stock list attached to the permit application shall be revised and those items disposed of during such day shall be so marked thereon.

Sec. 7-45. Only inventoried goods to be sold.

A permit issued under this article shall authorize only the sale of goods described in the inventory attached to the application for the permit, and the permittee shall make no additions whatsoever, during the period of authorized sale, to the stock of goods set forth in the inventory attached to the application for the permit.

Sec. 7-46. Advertising.

(a) All advertisements or advertising, and the language contained therein, used in connection with a sale shall be in accordance with the purpose of the sale as stated in the application pursuant to which a permit was issued under this article and the wording of such advertisements shall not vary from the wording as indicated in the application. Such advertising should contain a statement in these words and no others:

"Sale held pursuant to City of Oakland Park, Broward County, Fire and Going-Out-Of-Business Sale Permit # _____ granted the _____ day of _____,"

(in such blank spaces shall be indicated the type of sale, the permit number and the requisite dates).

(b) No person holding a permit for a sale under this article shall employ any untrue, deceptive or misleading advertising in connection with such sale.

(c) A person holding a permit for a sale under this article shall conduct such sale in strict conformity with any advertising or holding out incident thereto.
