The meeting is open to all residents, property and business owners, and its purpose is to get input and discuss the proposed Ordinances related to Outdoor Storage and Property Maintenance.

The meeting will focus on proposed restrictions on what items residents can store outdoors and property maintenance standards that need to be upheld. Examples of outdoor storage issues would be children’s toys left in a yard, miscellaneous items sitting in a carport; examples of a property maintenance issues would be sprinkler stains, mold on a barrel tile roof.

These Ordinances will also address the recommendations of the 2007 Compatibility study, resident and stakeholder expectations and City staff’s best planning practice recommendations for regulating land uses, improving community appearance neighborhood compatibility.
