

**CITY OF OAKLAND PARK  
LEGAL NOTICE**

A Public Hearing before the Oakland Park City Commission will be held Wednesday, August 4, 2010, at 6:30 P.M. or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Commission Chambers of City Hall at 3650 NE 12th Avenue, Oakland Park, Florida, to consider the following:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE BY THE CITY OF NOT EXCEEDING \$18,000,000 IN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF WATER AND SEWER REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2010A AND TAXABLE SERIES 2010B (BUILD AMERICA BONDS-DIRECT SUBSIDY), TO PAY A PORTION OF THE COSTS OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM, TO REFUND THE CITY'S UTILITY SYSTEM REVENUE REFUNDING AND IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 1994, TO PROVIDE FOR A DEBT SERVICE RESERVE AND TO PAY THE COSTS OF ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS; PLEDGING TO SECURE PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM, IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS CERTAIN PLEDGED FUNDS, INCLUDING THE NET REVENUES OF THE CITY'S WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM AND MONEYS ON DEPOSIT IN AND INVESTMENTS HELD FOR THE CREDIT OF CERTAIN FUNDS CREATED HEREUNDER; SETTING FORTH A METHOD TO ESTABLISH THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT, INTEREST RATES, MATURITY SCHEDULE AND REDEMPTION PROVISIONS FOR SUCH BONDS; AUTHORIZING CITY OFFICIALS TO AWARD THE SALE OF THE BONDS AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; APPOINTING A PAYING AGENT AND REGISTRAR FOR THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION AND USE OF A PRELIMINARY OFFICIAL STATEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FINAL OFFICIAL STATEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MUNICIPAL BOND INSURANCE POLICY FOR THE BONDS AND MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ESCROW DEPOSIT AGREEMENT AND FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ESCROW AGENT; MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE OWNERS OF SUCH BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS NO. R-93-162 AND R-94-13 OF THE CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the above City Commission with respect to any matter considered at such hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

All interested parties are invited to attend and be heard with respect to the above. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, persons needing a special accommodation or an interpreter to participate in this proceeding should contact the City Clerk's office at 954.630.4300 at least two days prior to the date of hearing.
